TENNESSEE BILL OF VOTING RIGHTS

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA SAYS THAT I HAVE THE RIGHT TO TAKE PART IN MY CIVIC LIFE.

IF I AM REGISTERED TO VOTE IN TENNESSEE, I HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE IN THIS ELECTION.

I HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE BY MYSELF OR WITH HELP.

I CAN SELECT WHO I WANT TO ASSIST ME.

EVEN IF I HAVE A CONSERVATOR, I MAY VOTE UNLESS A COURT SPECIFICALLY SAID I CANNOT.

I HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE THE WAY I WANT.

I HAVE THE RIGHT TO GET HELP IF SOMEONE TRIES TO STOP ME FROM VOTING.

I HAVE THE RIGHT TO BE SHOWN HOW TO MAKE MY CHOICES AT THE BALLOT.

IF I AM WAITING IN LINE WHEN THE POLL CLOSES, I MUST BE ALLOWED TO VOTE.

IF I AM PREVENTED FROM VOTING, I MAY STAY AT THE POLLING SITE AND CALL FOR HELP FROM ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:
